SUBJECT: INTERIM CHANGE (IC) 03-1 TO AFI 36-2903 ACC SUPPLEMENT 1, DRESS AND APPEARANCE OF AIR FORCE PERSONNEL, 25 APRIL 1997.

BEGIN CHANGE.

SUMMARY OF REVISIONS: IMPLEMENT THE WEAR OF BLACK BASEBALL CAPS. DESCRIBES WEAR OF HATS AND PATCHES BASED ON THE COMBAT WING REORGANIZATION FOR AIRCRAFT AND MUNITIONS MAINTAINERS. DESCRIBES THE WEAR OF NAME TAGS AND NECKWEAR ON THE FLIGHT

DRESS UNIFORM (FDU) FOR ACC STAFF MEMBERS. PROVIDES INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE COLOR AND LETTERING OF NAME TAGS FOR MEMBERS AUTHORIZED TO WEAR THE FDU ASSIGNED TO THE ACC STAFF. ESTABLISHES WEAR CRITERIA FOR "CAMEL PACK" WATER CONTAINERS WITH BDUS. AUTHORIZES WING COMMANDERS TO DIRECT WEAR OF US FLAG ON LEFT SLEEVE OF THE FDU.

MANDATORY WEAR DATE FOR WEAR OF BLACK BASEBALL CAPS IS NO LATER THAN 1 OCT 03.

TABLES 2.2, LINE 6 AND 2.4, LINE 9, ORGANIZATIONAL BASEBALL CAP. BLACK ORGANIZATIONAL BASEBALL CAPS WILL BE WORN WITH THE EXCEPTION OF RED HORSE SQUADRONS, WHO WILL CONTINUE TO WEAR RED BASEBALL CAPS. NOTE: MXG ORGANIZATIONAL BASEBALL CAPS WILL BE SOLID BLACK, WITH THE SQUADRON EMBLEM OF THE PARENT ORGANIZATION (E.G., 27 EMS, 27 AMXS) CENTERED ON THE FRONT WITH VERTICAL LETTERING ON BOTH SIDES. SQUADRON EMBLEMS WILL MATCH THAT WORN ABOVE THE NAME TAPE ON THE BDU AND WILL BE FULL COLOR, I.E. NOT SUBDUED. DESIGNATE THE UNIT NUMBER ON THE WEARER'S RIGHT AND THE UNIT ON THE WEARER'S LEFT (E.G., "27" ON THE RIGHT AND "EMS" ON THE LEFT). THE UNIT DESIGNATION LETTERS WILL BE THE COLOR OF THE PARENT ORGANIZATION (E.G., 27 EMS IN "WHITE"). IN THE EVENT THE UNIT NUMBER IS LESS THAN 10, APPROPRIATE ABBREVIATION SHOULD BE USED (E.G., 1ST OR 3RD). TWO EXCEPTIONS: PERSONNEL IN AMUS SUPPORTING ONLY ONE FLYING UNIT: UNIT DESIGNATION LETTERS WILL MATCH THE DEDICATED FLYING SQUADRON COLOR WITH THE FLYING SQUADRON NUMBER ON THE RIGHT AND THE LETTERS "AMU" ON THE LEFT (E.G. "71" ON THE RIGHT AND "AMU" ON THE LEFT IN "RED"). DEDICATED INSPECTION SECTION AND COMBAT AGE TEAM PERSONNEL: UNIT DESIGNATION LETTERS WILL MATCH THE DEDICATED FLYING SQUADRON COLOR AND WILL IDENTIFY THE SUPPORTED FLYING SQUADRON (E.G., "509" ON THE RIGHT AND "BS" ON THE LEFT IN "BLUE"). CAP EMBLEM AND LETTERING FOR MXG STAFF PERSONNEL WILL BE PRESCRIBED BY THE INSTALLATION COMMANDER. ACC PERSONNEL ARE AUTHORIZED TO WEAR THEIR ORGANIZATIONAL BASEBALL CAP WHEN DEPLOYED/TDY TO AN ACC OWNED BASE. HOWEVER, IF DEPLOYED TO A NON ACC BASE YOU MUST WEAR BDU/DCU CAP.

FIGURE 2.11., NOTE 3 (ADDED). INSTALLATION COMMANDERS PRESCRIBE WEAR OF "CAMEL PACK" WATER CONTAINERS WITH BDUS OR FDU WHILE ON THE INSTALLATION, E.G., LOCATION, TIME OF YEAR, ETC. "CAMEL PACK" WILL BE EITHER BLACK OR WOODLAND CAMOUFLAGE.

NOTE 3 (ADDED) EXCEPTION: MAINTENANCE GROUP (MXG) PERSONNEL WILL WEAR A SUBDUED COMMAND EMBLEM CENTERED ON THE RIGHT BREAST POCKET AND A SUBDUED WING EMBLEM ON THE LEFT BREAST POCKET WHEN AN APPROVED BADGE (SECURITY POLICE, FIRE PROTECTION, MISSILE, ETC.) IS NOT WORN ON THIS POCKET. AIRCRAFT

MAINTENANCE UNIT (AMU) PERSONNEL WILL CENTER THEIR DEDICATED FLYING SQUADRON EMBLEM 1/2 INCH ABOVE THE NAME TAPE. PERSONNEL IN AMUS SUPPORTING MULTIPLE FLYING UNITS AND ALL OTHER MXG PERSONNEL WILL CENTER THEIR ASSIGNED SQUADRON EMBLEM 1/2 INCH ABOVE THE NAME TAPE. MXG STAFF PERSONNEL WILL NOT WEAR UNIT EMBLEMS ABOVE THE NAME TAPE. COMMAND AND UNIT EMBLEMS WILL BE SUBDUED AND APPROXIMATELY 3 INCHES IN DIAMETER.

A2.4.3. NAME TAG. FOR PERSONNEL AUTHORIZED TO WEAR THE FDU ASSIGNED TO THE HQ ACC STAFF: LAST NAME IS MANDATORY AND COMMON NICKNAMES ARE AUTHORIZED PROVIDED THEY ARE IN GOOD TASTE. CLOTH EMBROIDERED, ROYAL BLUE BACKGROUND (NOT NAVY, NOT LIGHT BLUE), SILVER LETTERING, SILVER BORDER AND SILVER OCCUPATIONAL BADGE, SEE FIGURE 2.1.

A2.4.4.2. (ADDED). INSTALLATION COMMANDERS PRESCRIBE WEAR OF THE US FLAG ON THE FDU AS RED, WHITE AND BLUE; SUBDUED COLORED FLAGS ARE NOT AUTHORIZED. IF PRESCRIBED, IMPLEMENTATION WILL BE INSTALLATION WIDE AND WILL REPLACE APPROPRIATE PARENT WING, SEPARATE OPERATING GROUP, AIR DIVISION, OR NUMBERED AIR FORCE EMBLEM. FLAG APPROXIMATELY 2X3 INCHES WORN ON THE LEFT SHOULDER AND PLACED WITH STAR FIELD FACING FORWARD.

A2.4.5, NECKWEAR. FOR PERSONNEL AUTHORIZED TO WEAR THE FDU ASSIGNED TO THE HQ ACC STAFF: ACC STANDARD SCARF WILL BE WORN, SEE FIGURE 2.1.
